In response to Governor Beshear's executive order to move to remote learning with targeted services, Fulton County will have NTI again the week of November 30-December 4th. The faculty will report to school on November 30th and put together NTI packets for the rest of the week. On Tuesday, December 1st, there will be a Drop Off/Pick Up time where students and their guardians can drop off their last week's work and pick up their new NTI packets at the schools from 12:00-5:00 pm. An additional Drop Off/Pick Up will be at the Fulton Methodist Church parking lot in Fulton from 4:00-5:00 pm on December 1st.

Students in grades Preschool-Fifth grade will return to school on the regular Monday-Thursday schedule on December 7th unless the county is still in the red zone. If that occurs, the elementary and fifth grade will go to remote learning with targeted services much like the middle and high schools' plan below.

Students in grades 6-12 will be on remote learning with targeted services allowing students to come to the school in small groups for support and services at a scheduled time. Your child's principal and teachers will be contacting you with more information.

An information sheet on the schedule for December 7, 2020 through January 4, 2021 has been included in your child's NTI packet that you will pick up on December 1st.

Virtual students will continue with their regular curriculum and may come for targeted services at an appointed time on Fridays just as they have been doing.
